Courses Offered:

Charlotte's Web Remedial Readers Grade 1-4

This program will support and enrich Reading and Language Arts skills. The beautiful timeless story of Charlotte's Web will be used. The reading skills that will be addressed are: story elements, phonics, vocabulary, picture clues, predictions, making self to text connections, recall of details, theme and cause/effect. In Language Arts we will cover sentences, subject/predicate, nouns, verbs, adjectives and daily journal writing.

Math Support/Enrichment Grades 1-4

This active learning course will provide both support and enrichment. Grades 1-2 will focus on basic facts of addition and subtraction. Grades 3-4 will focus on multiplication and division facts. All students will tackle word problems, review concepts in measurement, time, geometry, fractions and geometry. iPads will be used to enhance learning.

Reading Language Arts (Grades 6-8)

This is an integrated remedial program that includes the elements of word study, context, and comprehension skills. Basic elements of English grammar and mechanics are reviewed to strengthen both sentence and paragraph structure

Remedial Math Skills Grades 4-8

In this course, students will recall basic facts and operations suitable for their grade level. Students will work to build familiarity with decimals, fractions, graphs, place value, measurements, probability, and geometry.

Remedial Pre-Algebra/Algebra Grades 7-8

Students will review algebraic equations and integers. They will solve one-step equations and inequalities. They will work with decimal and equations, operations with fractions, ratios, proportions and percent, two-step equations, area and volume, and introductory geometry.

Remedial Social Studies Grades 4-8

Areas covered include ancient history and American history. By working on content reading, students will practice the skills of locating main ideas, recalling facts, sequencing, fact and opinion, and cause and effect. Map and Globe skills will also be explored. Important middle grade study skills will be reinforced throughout this course.

Remedial Science Grades 4-8

In this course, we will cover Life Science, heredity, and DNA. Students will learn the differences between the structures of animals and plants, Newton's Laws of Motion, and about weather and technology. Students will collect data and present findings in tables and graphs. Middle grade study skills will be reinforced throughout this course.

Teachers will be available to discuss report cards upon request.

Registration: Registration by mail or in person. Enrollment is based on a first-come basis. Students will be accepted after classes begin only at the discretion of the director. **A \$50 non-refundable registration fee is required of all students. This payment must accompany the registration form and IS NOT PART OF THE TUITION.** Full tuition payment is due before classes begin. No tuition refunds will be issued after classes begin. All payments must be made in cash or by check payable to Queen of Peace Elementary School. Checks returned will incur a \$25 fee. Only cash or money orders will be accepted after classes begin.
